Turkey can't be 'energy hub if it rows with neighbors'

Turkey's political leaders might champion the country's "precious loneliness" as a virtue, but the stance means the country has no chance of realizing its dreams of becoming an energy hub, according to a scholar who focuses on energy issues.

"We want to be an energy

hub, but we can't become an energy hub when we have hostile relations with everybody," **Kadir Has University's** Volkan Ediger recently told the Hürriyet Daily News. "We need to be on talking terms and in friendships with all; in fact, energy can be a tool to strengthen friendship," he said.
